

BJORN BEAR FABRIC GUIDE

Use this guide to duplicate the fabric placement in the Child quilt shown in my Bjorn Bear pattern and in my Woodland Animals Craftsy class.

My original quilt was made using a combination of Kona Cotton Solids and prints from my Rhoda Ruth print fabric collection for Robert Kaufman Fabrics. These prints are no longer available, but you can easily duplicate the look of my quilt by substituting Kona Cotton Solids, as described in the guide below.

The eyes, noses, and glasses were made with Kona Espresso and the Muzzles were made with Kona Snow. For the background, I recommend Kona Oyster or Essex Yarn-Dyed Linen Blend in Oyster.



FABRICS FOR BEAR FACES AND EARS

If you would like to duplicate the color scheme that I used, I recommend using the following Kona Cotton Solids: Yarrow, Cerise, Mocha, Sangria, Taupe, Grelow, Gold, Terracotta, Brown, Chestnut, Curry, and Pomegranate. Many of these colors were used in my original quilt. I've just added more colors to substitute for the monochromatic prints that are no longer available.

Place the colors as follows (from left to right in each row):

ROW 1 Yarrow with Terracotta ears, Cerise with Pomegranate ears, and Mocha with Taupe ears

ROW 2 Sangria with Cerise ears, Taupe with Mocha ears, and Grelow with Gold ears

ROW 3 Gold with Curry ears, Terracotta with Yarrow ears, and Brown with Chestnut ears

ROW 4 Chestnut with Brown ears, Curry with Grelow ears, and Pomegranate with Sangria ears
