BJORN BEAR FABRIC GUIDE

Use this guide to duplicate the fabric placement in the Picnic Quilt shown on the cover of my Bjorn Bear pattern.

To make the bear faces and ears, I used 25 fat quarters of Robert Kaufman's Kona Cotton Solids. Please refer to the list below for colors and placement of those 25 colors.

The background fabric in this sample quilt is Essex Homespun Linen Blend in Indigo. The eyes, noses, and glasses were made with Kona Pepper and the Muzzles were made with Kona Snow.



KONA COLORS FOR BEAR FACES AND EARS

The following 25 colors were used: Thistle, Pansy, Violet, Cerise, Valentine, Tomato, Flame, Carrot, Mango, Peach, Corn Yellow, Wasabi, Peapod, Bluegrass, Emerald, Celestial, Cyan, Breakers, Pool, Aqua, Seafoam, Shale, Shadow, Pewter, and Graphite.

The colors were placed as follows (from left to right in each row):

ROW 1 Shadow with Shale ears, Pewter with Graphite ears, Graphite, with Shadow ears, Shale with Seafoam ears, and Seafoam with Pewter ears.

ROW 2 Aqua with Breakers ears, Pool with Aqua ears, Breakers with Celestial ears, Cyan with Pool ears, and Celestial with Cyan ears.

ROW 3 Corn Yellow with Peapod ears, Wasabi with Emerald ears, Peapod with Bluegrass ears, Bluegrass with Corn Yellow ears, and Emerald with Wasabi ears.

ROW 4 Peach with Tomato ears, Mango with Flame ears, Carrot with Peach ears, Flame with Mango ears, and Tomato with Carrot ears.

ROW 5 Thistle with Violet ears, Pansy with Cerise Ears, Violet with Valentine ears, Cerise with Thistle ears, and Valentine with Pansy ears.
